PROGRAM OUTLINE

- 1-month program, with 120-minute class per day, 3 days a week. (Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday).
- This program is designed for CEFR A2 or lower B1 level students. Students who have obtained JLPT N4 or at an equivalent level can apply.
- Those who have achieved close to the JLPT N3 upon completion of this program and are interested in an actual semester study abroad are eligible for SWU "Intensive Japanese Language Program."

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be an undergraduate or graduate student currently enrolled in a higher education institution outside of Japan.
- Must have completed introductory-level Japanese.
 e.g.) Completed 250-300 hours of Japanese language study or finished studying with the following textbooks:
- -「みんなの日本語1&2 (Minna no Nihongo I&I)」
- 「げんき1&2 (GENKI: An Integrated Course in Elementary Japanese |&II)」
