Impressionism

The style of painting known as Impressionism, which began approximately 150 years ago in France, remains one of the most appreciated forms of art today. It may be difficult to say exactly why 21 After all, art is often valued for its ability to move our emotions, and we are not all equally moved by the same images. However, Impressionist paintings share certain characteristics, and these characteristics may explain what makes Impressionism so appealing.

The Impressionist movement is closely connected with the 1874 Paris exhibition that later became known as the "Exhibition of the Impressionists." At this event, 31 painters, including Cézanne, Degas, Monet, and Renoir, showed their art. One of these works was Mone's *Impression, Sunrise*, which depicts a sunrise in the harbor of Le Havre, France. Instead of painting precise details, as a more traditional painter might have done, Monet used loose brush strokes to create a sense of foginess. In fact, there seems to be no clear line between the water and the sky. The painting does not show the scene as it appears in reality, but creates an impression of what one might feel when viewing it. 22 the 1874 exhibition used techniques like Monet's to achieve similar effects. Therefore, the journalist Louis Leroy used the term "Impressionists" in an article to refer to the group as a whole, and their artistic movement became known as "Impressionism."

In addition to their innovative techniques, Impressionists used new types of paint which came in bright colors that 23 Earlier, mixing paint had been a time-consuming and messy process, requiring artists to mix their paint and do their painting in a studio. The new paints, however, were already mixed and came in tubes, allowing artists to use them outside. Because Impressionists became interested in the effects of natural light on scenery. They tried to show these effects in their work, making use of the bright colors in the new paints.

Impressionist painters also differed from earlier painters in the subjects they chose. In earlier styles of painting, the subjects were often well-known historical or religious figures, or members of the upper class. Impressionists, on the other hand, tended to 25 Their subjects included ordinary people enjoying a picnic, going to the theater, or talking in a cafe.

Impressionist art may appeal to different people for different reasons. People may appreciate the painter's technique, the bright colors, or the everyday subject matter. Or, a painting may simply create an overall impression that attracts them. In that case, it seems that "Impressionism" is indeed an appropriate name for this popular art form.
